Amateur Gun Dog and Open Gun Dog are retrieving stakes with callback for retrieve.

A blank cartridge will **NOT** be fired in Open Puppy & Amateur Walking Puppy Shotguns with blank shells will **NOT** be permitted.

Horseback handling will **NOT** be permitted in any stake.

Tracking collars permitted per AKC rules and regulations, and are permitted in the callback for retrieve.

Orange vests are mandatory for judges, handlers, marshals, gunners and bird planters during callback for retrieve.
